NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS

In accordance with § 2.1 of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act, Act No. 38-2017, as amended, and Art. 3 of the University of Puerto Rico Act, Act No. 1 of January 20, 1966, as amended, the Governing Board of the University of Puerto Rico notifies that it proposes to approve:

- (1) The *Procedure for the Intra- and Inter-Unit Movement of Professors at the University of Puerto Rico*, with the purpose of formalizing and establishing the procedure for the personnel actions that require relocating teaching personnel as part of the consolidation or elimination of academic programs; establishing the criteria to be taken into consideration to carry out this movement of teaching staff; and to prepare and establish a Registry of Teaching Personnel, among other matters.
- (2) The Institutional Policy for the Authorization of Prolonged Absences Applicable to Students of the University of Puerto Rico, with the purpose of allowing students to temporarily separate from their studies in certain circumstances to attend to personal or core health or family situations, in case of a national emergencies, or other extraordinary situations, among other matters.

During a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the publication of this Notice, persons interested in submitting comments or a request for an oral hearing on the proposed actions must do so in writing, in any of the following ways: (a) sending an email to comentario.RG@upr.edu; (b) sending a letter by postal mail to PO Box 23326, San Juan, PR 00931-3326; or (c) presenting written comments personally at the office of the Governing Board, at the physical address indicated above from 8:00 am to 4:30 p.m., on working days. Every request for an oral hearing must include the specific grounds that, in the opinion of the applicant, makes necessary to grant it.
